Annual Grant Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.

Grant Information

- Annual grant applications are accepted once a year.
 - Annual grant projects are to be completed within one year. Funding runs July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.
- The goal of the grant program is to encourage all persons at Glacier Hills (colleagues and residents) to submit ideas that focus on programs and projects not currently funded through operating budgets that enhance the Glacier Hills community in which we live, play, and work.
- A selection committee comprised of Foundation Board members, residents, and colleagues will review each grant application to ensure that the information presented is achievable, measureable, realistic, and reasonable. The selection committee reserves the right to partially fund, completely fund, or reject any submitted proposals.
- Foundation Grant Applications *require* signatures from the appropriate supervisor or director before submission to the Foundation.
